On the 16th and 17th of October the assessment panel meeting took place with successful Wave Seven initiatives due to be released shortly



NOTES TO RESULTS

- 1. Whānau engagement increased significantly this quarter (52%) following an improvement in data reporting.
- 2. The Whānau Enhancement workstream has already reached (43%) of cumulative engagement from FY16/17.
- 3. There is now a navigator placed on Wharekauri (Chatham Islands).

CASE STUDY (WHĀNAU STORY)

Nikau has been in and out of the justice system for the last ten years, spending three full years in prison. Recently he joined the navigation supported provided by Te Pūtahitanga, helping him to devise a plan with goals such as, living drug and alcohol free, being a good partner and father, breaking his current gang affiliations and creating a positive family environment. Nikau despite some setbacks, has now broken free from gangs, found employment and has made big strides towards his long term goals.
