Official Information Act request

Thank you for your information request dated 25 May 2024. You asked for the following information:

“Please see the OIA request for information below on behalf of [REDACTED] directed to TPK, who have staff seconded to the affairs of Te Runanga A Iwi O Ngapuhi (TRAION) and subsequent access to information of the organisation:

- 1. How many individuals 18 years and over, are registered to TRAION as at 30 June 2024*
- 2. How many individuals 18 years and over, alive and not deceased, are registered to TRAION, as at 30 June 2024*
- 3. How many individuals 18 years and over, are registered with TRAION and reside in Auckland, as at 30 June 2024*
- 4. How much in dollars, was received by way of Government department contracts between 30 June 2019 to 30 June 2024 and from which Government departments? (please list with amounts)*
- 5. How much in dollars was received in distributions from the Ngapuhi Asset Holding Company from 30 June 2019 to 30 June 2024 across each financial year?*
- 6. How many TRAION staff, by percentage of the total staff, have an address residing in Kaikohe as at 30 June 2024?*
- 7. How many TRAION staff, by percentage of the total staff, have an address with their home residence being in Auckland as at 30 June 2024?*
- 8. What TRAION services, if any, of the TRAION group, service Auckland-registered TRAION members, and if any, please list the service.*
- 9. How many TRAION Auckland-registered TRAION members, if any, received a TRAION service from 30 June 2023 to 30 June 2024?*
- 10. What registration data, if any, is shared between TRAION and a Takiwa in Auckland, to enable engagement with its registered members, if any?”*

Your request has been considered in accordance with the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

Te Puni Kōkiri does not hold the information requested. Accordingly, your request is refused in full under section 18(g)(i) of the Act as the information requested is not held by the department and there are no grounds for believing that the information is held by, or more closely connected with the functions of another Minister of agency.

The information you have requested may be held by Te Rūnanga-Ā-Iwi-ō-Ngāpuhi. However we note that they are not subject to the OIA.

I trust my response satisfies your request.
