

Official Information Act request

Thank you for your information request dated 7 October 2024. You asked for the following information:

"What information is held regarding costs to the taxpayer for the Maori kings tangi"?

Your request has been considered in accordance with the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

The information held by Te Puni Kokiri regarding costs to the taxpayer include department expenditure relating koha and travel costs to Kīngi Tuheitia's tangihanga. The total of this expenditure was \$2,645, and a breakdown of spend is provided in the table below:
