Official Information Act request

Thank you for your information request dated 21 April 2020. You asked for the following information:

- *“All correspondence including letters, briefs, memos, emails, texts and phone calls between Te Puni Kokiri staff and government Ministers, government officials, iwi organisations, marae, Māori urban authorities and/or Māori health providers regarding the initial Māori covid-19 response plan (correspondence to include the 12 weeks prior to the initial Māori covid-19 response plan announcement up to the date of this email).*
- *All correspondence including letters, briefs, memos, emails, texts and phone calls, between Te Puni Kokiri staff and government Ministers, officials, iwi organisations, marae, Māori urban authorities and/or Māori health providers regarding the \$50m in funding for Māori communities to respond to covid-19 that was announced on 22 March (correspondence to include the 8 weeks prior to the funding announcement up until the date of this email).*
- *A breakdown of where the \$50m in funding announced on 22 March has been spent, and a list of all the organisations this money has been given to, and how much they were given”*

On 24 April 2020 you also made the following request to the Minister for Māori Development:

1. *All correspondence including letters, briefs, memos, emails, texts and phone calls regarding the announcement of \$56 million in funding for Māori communities to fight covid-19 announced on 22 March (correspondence to include the 8 weeks prior to the announcement up to the date of this email).*
2. *All correspondence including letters, briefs, memos, emails, texts and phone calls regarding the Ministry of Health's Initial COVID-19 Māori Response Action Plan (correspondence to include the 12 weeks prior to the release of the plan on 16 April up to the date of this email).*

On 29 April 2020 this request was transferred to Te Puni Kōkiri for a response.

On 7 May 2020 you clarified the scope of your requests as follows:

1. *All written correspondence to and from the Minister for Māori Development where the subject line includes both: "Māori" and "covid-19" for the period of 23 February - 16 April.*
2. *All written correspondence between Te Puni Kōkiri staff and government Ministers, officials, marae, Māori urban authorities and/or Māori health providers where the subject line includes: "Māori" and "covid-19".*
3. *A breakdown of where the \$56 in funding announced on 22 March has been spent, including a list of all the organisations this money was given to, and how much they were given each.*

On 20 May 2020 Te Puni Kōkiri notified you of an extension on the timeframe for the response, to 25 June 2020.

Your request has been considered in accordance with the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

This letter responds to part (3) of your request, for "*A breakdown of where the \$56 in funding announced on 22 March has been spent, including a list of all the organisations this money was given to, and how much they were given each.*"

When the COVID-19 response funding package was announced it was broken down as follows:

1. \$10 million to support community outreach (the Whānau Māori Community and Marae Response Fund)
2. \$15 million to support Whānau Ora Commissioning Agencies
3. \$1 million to support needs assessments for Māori businesses
4. \$0.47 million for Te Arawhiti to engage and work with iwi on pandemic response plans – Te Arawhiti
5. \$30 million to support Māori health services – Health portfolio.

This response provides information related to items 1-3 above. The following table sets out information related to the three funding areas:

The Māori response to COVID-19 funding allocated to the three Whānau Ora Commissioning Agencies was distributed based on the existing Commissioning Agency funding allocation model.

With regard to the Whānau Māori Community and Marae Response Fund and Rangatiratanga Grants for COVID-19, the information provided relates to the recipients as at 19 May 2020. The information details the investments made from funds directly managed by Te Puni Kōkiri. The key focus of the agreements and grants to date has been to:

- provide essential supplies for whānau including kaumatua, kuia and the Māori disabled community
- establish systems and networks that assists whānau to connect to essential health and support services
- develop collective response, coordination, or communication plans
- share messaging across multiple platforms and ensure messaging is recorded and communicated
- provide business support and advisory services to whānau/Māori.

The remaining \$6 million of the Whānau Māori Community and Marae Response Fund will be utilised in the next phases of COVID-19 response and recovery.


